



NATIONAL COST OF LONG TERM CARE SURVEY

June 2010

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Univita Health, Inc. has completed the 2010 Cost of Care study the cost of care for Home Health Care, Assisted Living Facilities and Skilled Nursing Facilities across specific regions throughout the United States.

Univita surveyors made outbound calls to key metropolitan statistical areas and other local regions to obtain data for this study. Professionally trained Customer Service Representatives placed the calls to obtain the data. Rates obtained include private pay rates for single occupancy rooms in Medicare-certified skilled nursing facilities, hourly rates for Home Health Aides for Medicare-certified and non-certified Home Health Care Agencies, and monthly rates for Assisted Living Facilities.

The surveyors contacted more than 2,000 Nursing Homes, 2,000 Assisted Living Facilities, and 2,000 Home Health Care Agencies to complete over 6,000 surveys between April and May 2010. METHODOLOGY: SKILLED NURSING FACILITIES

The Skilled Nursing Facility industry is comprised of establishments primarily engaged in providing inpatient nursing and rehabilitative services. The care is generally provided for an extended period of time to individuals requiring nursing care. These establishments have a permanent core staff of registered or licensed practical nurses that, along with other staff, provide nursing and continuous personal care services.

According to the NAICS, Skilled Nursing Care Facilities are establishments primarily engaged in providing inpatient nursing and rehabilitative services to patients who require continuous health care, but not hospital services. This does not include continuing care retirement communities or psychiatric hospitals. Care must be ordered by and remain under the direction of a physician. The staff must include a licensed nurse on duty continuously with a minimum of one full-time registered nurse on duty during each day shift. Included are establishments certified to deliver skilled nursing care under the Medicare and Medicaid programs.

Nursing home facilities generally offer accommodations of either private rooms, or semi-private rooms shared between two or more residents. Private rooms may have a private bathroom or a bathroom shared between two adjoining rooms. Some facilities charge more for a private room with a private bathroom versus a private room with a shared bathroom. The daily room charge usually includes services beyond the daily bed charge (rent), such as three meals a day, laundry services, basic nurse supervision, and generic-brand, over the counter (OTC) or non-prescription pharmaceuticals. Nursing facilities are responsible for providing OTC pharmaceutical services when they are specified in the resident's plan of care.

Sampling Procedures: Skilled Nursing Facilities

The sample population was derived from a list of approximately 16,000 Medicare-certified Skilled Nursing Facilities. Across all of the defined regions, surveyors polled at least 10% of all certified Skilled Nursing Facilities without exception. At least 10 facilities completed the survey in all regions while many regions yielded significantly larger sample sizes. More than 2,000 total providers contributed data to this study. Data collected includes the daily rate for a private room (single occupant) in Medicare-certified nursing facilities.

Data Collection: Skilled Nursing Facilities

- Data collected includes daily private pay room rate for private (single occupant) nursing home room
- Results presented include average, maximum and minimum values within each region and in total

Procedure: Skilled Nursing Facilities

- Survey certified skilled nursing facilities in all regions identified
- Survey 10% of providers per region or at least 10 providers in each region, unless impracticable for a minimum of 2,000 completed surveys

METHODOLOGY: HOME HEALTH CARE

Home Health Aides provide routine, personal health care to elderly, convalescent, or disabled persons in home or residential care settings. Home Health Aides assist elderly or disabled persons with activities of daily living, including bathing, dressing, grooming, eating, transferring, toileting and other services to persons who would otherwise require a nursing home level of care. Duties performed at a place of residence may include housekeeping (making beds, doing laundry, washing dishes) and preparing meals. Home Health Aides may provide meals and supervised activities at non-residential care facilities. They also may advise families, the elderly and disabled on such things as nutrition, cleanliness and household utilities.

Home care organizations include home health care agencies, home care aide organizations, and hospice facilities. Some of these organizations are Medicare certified, which allows providers to bill Medicare for reimbursement. Agencies that are not Medicare certified cannot be reimbursed through Medicare.

Sampling Procedure: Home Health Care

The sample population is a list comprised of over 25,000 Medicare-certified home care agencies. Across all regions, surveyors polled a minimum of 10% of home care providers across state licensed Medicare-certified and state licensed non Medicare-certified provider types to determine the hourly private pay rates charged for the services of a Home Health Aide.

In regions with smaller available sample sizes, a minimum of ten (10) providers completed surveys for the region. In many areas, the sample size was substantially larger. Surveyors completed over 2,000 surveys to obtain Home Health Care data.

All rates referred to throughout this document are weekday (Monday – Friday) rates, unless otherwise noted. Surveyors found that agencies often have a higher weekend hourly rate, with a differential premium of \$2.00 to \$10.00 per hour more than weekday (Monday-Friday) rates.

Data Collection: Home Health Care

- Data collected includes:
 - Hourly private pay rate for a Home Health Aide (certified provider)
 - Hourly private pay rate for a Home Health Aide (non-certified provider)
- Results presented include average, maximum and minimum values within each region and in total.

Procedure: Home Health Care

Surveyors completed outbound calls to at least ten (10) home health care providers in each of the regions outlined in this study, for a total of over 2,000 completed surveys. In regions where contacting ten (10) providers was deemed impracticable (i.e. small quantity of facilities), at least 10% of providers in the region were surveyed; in many cases more than 10% were surveyed. Surveyors collected data on the cost for a certified Home Health Aide based on hourly, private pay rates. Rates obtained reflect weekday (Monday – Friday) figures.

METHODOLOGY: ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES

The Assisted Living Facility industry is comprised of establishments primarily engaged in providing care to individuals who wish to live as independently as possible, but require some assistance with their Activities of Daily Living (ADLs). ADLs include bathing, dressing, eating, toileting, continence and transferring. Assisted Living Facilities generally offer accommodations of either private rooms, or rooms shared between two or more residents. Private rooms may have a private bathroom or a bathroom shared between two adjoining rooms. Some facilities charge more for a private room with a private bathroom versus a private room with a shared bathroom.

Sampling Procedures: Assisted Living Facilities

The sample population was derived from a list of approximately 40,000 Assisted Living Facilities. Across all of the 99 defined regions, surveyors polled at least 10% of all Assisted Living Facilities. At least 10 facilities completed the survey in all regions while many regions yielded significantly larger sample sizes. More than 2,000 total providers contributed data to this study. Data collected includes the daily rate for a private room (single occupant) and the daily rate for a semi-private or shared room.

Data Collection: Assisted Living Facilities

- Data collected includes daily private pay room rate for private (single occupant) room, and the daily private pay room rate for a semi-private or shared room
- Results presented include average, maximum and minimum values within each region and in total

Procedure: Assisted Living Facilities

- Survey Assisted Living Facilities in all regions identified
- Survey 10% of providers per region or at least 10 providers in each region, unless impracticable for a minimum of 2,000 completed surveys

RESULTS AND KEY FINDINGS

- The National average annual cost of a private room in a Medicare-certified Skilled Nursing Facility for all regions surveyed in this study is \$90,155.
- The average daily rate for a single occupancy, private room in a Medicare-certified Skilled Nursing Facility is \$247.
- The region with the most expensive daily average rate for a private, single occupancy room in a Medicare-certified Skilled Nursing Facility is Anchorage, Alaska and costs \$576 per day.
- The region with the least expensive daily average rate for a private, single occupancy room in a Medicare-certified Skilled Nursing Facility is Lafayette, Louisiana and costs \$143 per day.
- The national average hourly rate for Home Health Aides provided by a certified Home Health Care Agency is \$22.14 per hour.
- The region with the highest average hourly rate for Home Health Aides provided by a certified Home Health Care Agency is Stamford, Connecticut at \$34.85 per hour.
- The region with the lowest average hourly rate for Home Health Aides provided by a certified Home Health Care Agency is Shreveport, Louisiana with a cost of \$14.50 per hour.
- The national average hourly rate for Home Health Aides provided by a non-certified Home Health Care Agency is \$18.41 per hour.
- The region with the highest average hourly rate for Home Health Aides provided by a non-certified Home Health Care Agency is San Francisco, California at \$24.70 per hour.
- The region with the lowest average hourly rate for Home Health Aides provided by a non-certified Home Health Care Agency is Brooklyn, New York with a cost of \$11.90 per hour.
- The average monthly rate for a private, single occupancy room in an Assisted Living Facility is \$3,294.67 per month.
- The average monthly rate for a semi-private room in an Assisted Living Facility is \$2,025.28 per month.
